Updates (Eve)

Budget

- \$50 million new money coming to campus from American Rescue Plan Funds. \$25 million will need to be spent on student aid, however the timeline is longer to spend the money (at least until 2023), so universities could use that to offset other monies they would have spent next year on financial aid. There will also be state money coming in which can be used on anything except for tax cuts.
- Administration is telling colleges and schools that there will be \$5 million. They're "being cautious, so much uncertainty. Saving for the future."
- Fall plan only one faculty member on the Chancellor's committee, concern about faculty governance.
- Also concerned about Flexible Learning task force, moving forward quickly, also with a lot of administrators. Kate Hudson and Steve Brewer are on this task force.
- CNS Strives hired a consultant, Segal Consulting, to restructure the College. Concern that it's about cutting staff, but it's unclear. Union leaders met with Segal yesterday.
- Multi-unions, everyone is going back to the bargaining table. The Bargaining summit
 (scheduled for tomorrow) will focus on four common coalition demands. 1) pay, including
 merit going back six years, flat sum for health insurance increases; 2) full-staffing; 3)
 more holiday (campus closure days); 4) Climate Justice/Green New Deal proposals
- Unclear what the transition is going to look like in terms of hybrid work options as we transition back to campus (allowing people to work from home in some way.) Could drive a wedge between librarians if different unions have different options

Bargaining Updates (Asha)
